PNWD Challenge Classes

This section is **open** only to **ARS members** that are either registered for this Convention or the 3 Day World Rose Festival Pass (Refer Rule #2 of the ARS Horticulture Rules, Information, Definitions) and are eligible under the rules of the various classes (see classes PNW1, 3 and 11 for specific rules). Only one (1) entry per class from any one garden is permitted. **Hybrid tea and grandiflora roses may be used interchangeably.**

PNWD Exhibitor's Rules and Regulations

Please refer to the **ARS Rules Information and Definitions of the Horticulture and Arrangement sections detailed in this schedule.** Please make sure to put **PNW** beside the class number. All vases must have an entry tag completed and attached. All Exhibitors must have an Exhibitor number. All trophies are Keepsake Awards donated by the various Rose Societies, families, Trusts, Estates and individuals from the Pacific Northwest.

PNWD Challenge Classes

Class	Title	Description
PNW1	The J. Horace McFarland Memorial Trophy	<i>NOTE - Open only to ARS members who reside in the Pacific Northwest District. A collection of six (6) hybrid tea blooms, no more than two of any variety, each displayed in separate containers, with a separate entry tag on each container labeled as to variety and Exhibitor. Trophy donated by the Salem Rose Society.</i>
PNW2	The Al Schamel Memorial Trophy	An entry of five (5) hybrid tea or grandiflora blooms of the same variety, displayed in one container. <i>Trophy donated by the Portland Rose Society.</i>



Class	Title	Description
PNW3	The Robert MacGavin Memorial Judges' Trophy	<i>NOTE - Open to all PNW judges registered at this convention whether or not they are judging in the show. Three (3) different exhibition blooms, displayed in one container. This award may be won only once every three years by the same Exhibitor(s). Trophy donated by the MacGavin Family.</i>
PNW4	The Dr. Paul and Carrie Miller Memorial Trophy	A classic bloom progression. One (1) variety of hybrid tea or grandiflora displayed in a single vase, the bud at the top and the exhibition bloom in the middle and a fully open bloom with the stamens visible at the bottom. <i>Trophy donated by the Miller Trust.</i>
PNW5	The Fred Edmunds Jr. Memorial Trophy	One (1) bloom per stem Hybrid Tea and one (1) bloom per stem miniature in separate vases, both exhibition type, matching characteristics, matching color class, blends allowed. Each container with a separate entry tag. Example: Elina and Luis Desamero. The mini will be staged on a special stand; both specimens will be staged on a mirror located in the display area. Materials will be furnished on a first come, first served basis. <i>Trophy donated by the District Director, Jack Kiley.</i>
PNW6	Eleanor Conti Memorial Trophy	One (1) hybrid tea, one (1) floribunda, and one (1) miniature/mini-flora, same color class. All correctly named and displayed in separate containers with a separate entry tag on each container. <i>Trophy donated by the Eleanor Conti Estate.</i>
PNW7	The Seattle Rose Society Floribunda Trophy	Three (3) different varieties (any colour) of floribunda sprays in one vase. <i>Trophy donated by the Seattle Rose Society.</i>
PNW 8	The Lee Allen Memorial Trophy	Five (5) stems of different varieties of Old Garden Roses, displayed in one container. <i>Trophy donated by the Albany Rose Society.</i>



Class	Title	Description
PNW 9	The PNW District Shrub Trophy	Three (3) stems of different varieties of shrub roses, displayed in one container. <i>Trophy donated by the Olympia Rose Society.</i>
PNW10	The Helene Schoen Memorial Trophy	Rainbow Bloom progression, consisting of three (3) different hybrid tea and/or grandiflora's displayed in a single vase, the bud at the top and the exhibition bloom in the middle and a fully open bloom, with the stamens visible, at the bottom. <i>Trophy donated by the Fort Vancouver Rose Society.</i>
PNW11	The ARS Ralph S. Moore District Trophy	<i>NOTE - Open only to ARS members who reside in the Pacific Northwest District.</i> Seven (7) miniature roses, each a different variety, exhibited in separate containers with each container with a separate entry tag labeled as to variety and Exhibitor. All blooms must be exhibition stage. <i>Trophy donated by the Valley Rose Society.</i>
PNW12	The Spokane Rose Society Miniature Rose Trophy	Three (3) sprays of miniature roses, different varieties, displayed in one container. <i>Trophy donated by the Spokane Rose Society.</i>
PNW13	The Vic Snitzler Memorial Trophy	Three (3) different exhibition-form miniatures or mini-floras in one container. <i>Trophy donated by Margaret Snitzler.</i>
PNW14	The Betty and Walt Gutoski Arrangement Trophy	"The Champagne of Roses" Traditional Line-Mass, Standard arrangement with "AG" (arranger grown) roses, correctly identified. Fresh plant material and other roses MUST be included. Subordinate accessory/ies permitted. <i>Trophy donated by the Tacoma Rose Society.</i>
