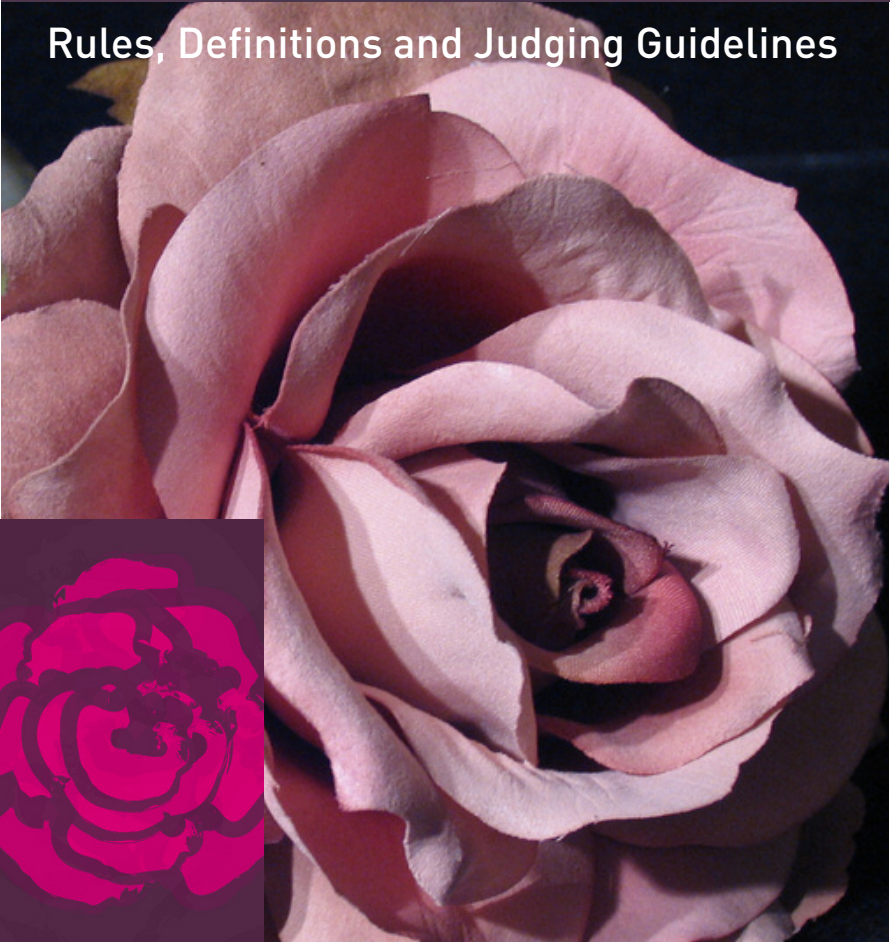

International Challenge Classes

WFRS Gold Certificates of Excellence will be awarded to the first place winners of classes WF1, WF2, WF3 and WF4. Rosettes and Keepsake Awards will also be awarded. The WF classes will not be eligible for any other VRS awards.

VRS Judging Rules (located in the next section) will prevail except as follows:

- Entries in these classes can be made by individual exhibitors or by members of a Rose Society joining together to make up an entry.
- Misnaming of a rose is NOT grounds for disqualification, although it should not be encouraged.
- International judging point scale will apply to classes 1 to 4, as follows:

- Form 25 points
- Color 20 points
- Substance 15 points
- Stem & Foliage 20 points
- Presentation 20 points

(Exhibit should be gracefully balanced in relation to container for height and width, multiple stems should show good color combinations, blooms and foliage should be placed in container so as to avoid either crushing or excessive gaps and the blooms should always dominate the exhibit. In multiple stem exhibits, the blooms should be uniform in size and stage of development.)

Class	Vase	Description
WF1	J K N	Bowl – a bowl (VRS or your own) of 12 or more hybrid tea stems, one bloom per stem, 4 or more varieties.
WF2	K	Bowl – a LARGE bowl (VRS or your own) of 12 or more sprays of Floribundas or Shrubs or a combination of both, 4 or more varieties.
WF3	K	Bowl – a LARGE bowl (VRS or your own) of 12 or more stems of Old Garden roses, 4 or more varieties.
WF4		Bowl – your own small bowl of 18 or more stems of Miniature or Mini-Flora roses or a combination of both, one or more varieties, not to exceed 10 inches in height, width or depth, including container.
